ATTENTION SENIORS! NEW PROPERTY TAX RELIEF FORM (PAS-1) FOR ALL THREE RELIEF PROGRAMS: ANCHOR, SENIOR FREEZE & STAY NJ

Seniors (age 65 and over) and those collecting Social Security Disability Benefits in New Jersey can apply for Property Tax Relief with a new, simplified **single combined application**. The single application covers Senior Freeze (Property Tax Reimbursement), ANCHOR, and the new Stay NJ program (which reimburses applicants for 50% of their property tax bills, capped at \$6,500).

New Jersey residents 65 or older and those collecting Social Security Disability Benefits have a new method to file for the Tax Year 2024 property tax relief programs. The Division of Taxation will provide a single combined application for the Stay NJ, ANCHOR, and Property Tax Reimbursement (Senior Freeze) programs. The combined application is Form PAS-1, State of New Jersey Application for Property Tax Relief for Seniors and Social Security Disability Recipients.

The Division of Taxation has been mailing Form PAS-1 to residents it believes may be eligible for one or all of the property tax relief benefits. **However, if you have not received a Form PAS-1, it does not mean you aren't ineligible.**

IMPORTANT NOTE: Unlike previous years, when the state would automatically file a new application on behalf of residents who received the benefits in the prior year, you must fill out a new application for the 2024 tax year.
